Till 09-04-2020, Lodhran Pilot Project (LPP) reached up to 1 million people in the COVID-19 pandemic through its different initiatives. Emergency response is being provided in three districts of Punjab named Lodhran, Multan and Jhang. LPP has been able to respond to the situation with the support of UNICEF, Concern Worldwide, district governments, community networks and its dedicated implementation team deployed.

Role of District Government in Lodhran

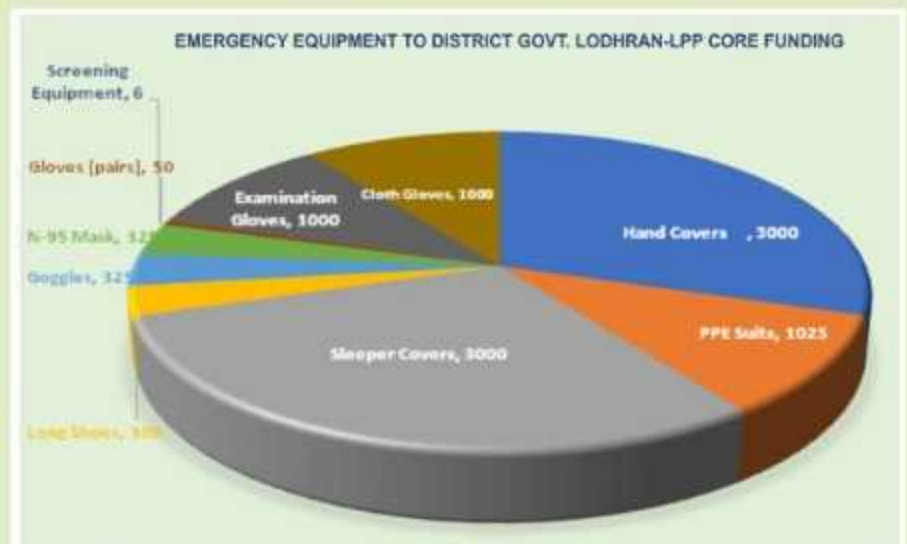
At a grassroots level, district government has first-hand knowledge of community's social, economic, infrastructural and environmental needs to provide support in a disaster. Government of Pakistan is taking appropriate results under the COVID-19 situation majorly focusing on enhancing capability to combat the pandemic. Preparing disaster management plan at local levels to ensure disaster information is promptly given to the stakeholders.

LPP's Social Responsibility Initiatives & Provision of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Kits

Under the emergency situation LPP initiated its response to capacitate and update its communities through different initiatives. Through social responsibility initiatives, LPP is playing an instrumental role to reach out maximum vulnerable communities and bridging the gaps in COVID-19 pandemic. Upon the request of district government Lodhran, LPP provided PPE kits to health department.

Distribution of 2000 Ration Packs



In first phase LPP distributed 3000 Ration packs among daily wagers, elderly, people with disability, widows and people falling under the criteria, "poor of the poorest". In 2nd phase, more 2000 ration packs were distributed following the same vulnerability criteria.
