**Community Orientation Session on Women Protection Laws & Acts under LPP Toll-free Helpline Program in District Lodhran**

## Our Achievements Towards Building a Resilient Society in Pakistan

- Established 05 Vocational Skills Development Centers at Taunsa (Dera Ghazi Khan) & Lodhran and enrolled 221 women from poor families on Dress Designing & Tailoring to promote food security and livelihoods of vulnerable groups.
- LPP in collaboration with CIRCLE Women Association trained 2000 marginalized women under its Digital Literacy Project (DLP) in District Multan and Lodhran. Activity aimed at improving socio-economic status of the potential trainees and equip them with the modern entrepreneurial and marketing skills.
- Created enabling environment towards Girls' Education through construction and rehabilitation of 20 classrooms and 30 toilets of Government Girls' Primary, Elementary schools in Tehsil Alipur of District Muzaffargarh.
- 240 teachers of Government Girls' Primary, Elementary, and High Schools in Alipur Tehsil enhanced their capacity and skills on Activity Based Learning (ABL) and Multigrade Teaching Methods (MGT).

- 40 students have been enrolled in E-Commerce and Graphic Designing class in District Bahawalpur in “Strengthening the socio-economic resilience of youth by promoting their economic self-reliance in three provinces of Pakistan”.
- LPP handed over the IT Equipment’s to Public Welfare Society Bahawalpur, for their Office establishment.
- 390 families were provided Cash for Work (CfW) for Environmental restoration through communal and urban forest Miyawaki/Permaculture principles.
- 500 flood-affected female community members were provided with Menstrual Hygiene Management /Dignity Kits & knowledge sessions.
- 249 flood effected families were provided with cash grants of (PKR 18,000 each) to meet their instant needs.

- Provided improved learning environment to 880, students of Government Girls’ Primary Schools through extracurricular activities of Sports and Art competitions in Alipur.
- Facilitated 02 exposure visits of the partner organizations of UNESCO (Rupali Foundation and MID) working in Gilgit Baltistan in Alipur Tehsil.
- LPP in collaboration with the Government Education department and through the financial assistance of UNESCO established 2 Computer Labs, 2 Tailoring Labs and 2 Beautician Labs for Trans students in Multan and Bahawalpur.
- Trans students were provided with consumable training products, uniform, stationery and honorarium in both districts.
- 240 youth identified and selected for 6-month vocational training under the project “CSOs Building Resilience through Improved Delivery, Governance and Empowerment Programme (The CSOs BRIDGE Programme)”.
- EU Delegation including Ms. Saadia Ainuddin, Ms. Aisha Jamshed Country Director WHH, & Dr. Abdul Saboor (CEO-LPP) conducted program review meeting with Deaf Welfare Society, Focus Transgender Organization, Bahar Social Development Organization, District Civil Society Network, (DCSN) Local authorities (LAs) & Tehsil Action Group (TAG) in District Bahawalpur.
- US Counsel Representative General Public Affairs met with District Civil Society Network and exchanged knowledge for the Sustainable Development in District Bahawalpur.
- US Counsel General Economic Affairs participated in the International Women Days’ events in Bahuddin Zakariya University Multan and expressed her gratitude towards the Girls Empowerment by providing them Scotties.

- LPP established Business of Honey Harvesting at Urban Forest and given its supervision to Transgender community and enabled them to earn 48000/- PKRs from 24 KG honey.
- 1174 patients were treated and 184 eye successful surgeries were done under the renowned surgeons of Pakistan in the Free Eye Camp in District Lodhran. 41 patients were treated with Intraocular lenses-IOLs, 75 with PTRG, 40 with eye probing, 46 patients with general treatment, 21 for Reactive Oxygen Species (ROS), 01 with Phacoemulsification, & 01 with foreign body removal.
