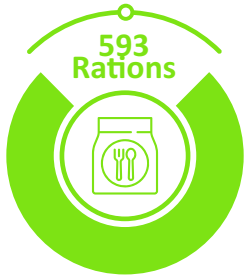




## Flood Relief: "Restoring Hope in Communities"

## Empowering Youth for Socio-economic Resilience

LPP focuses on supporting marginalized youth to enhance their economic prospects through technical and vocational training, leading to improved stability for individuals and their families. In (Pak1118) project LPP trained 340 Youth in Bahawalpur Division.

LPP in collaboration with BMZ and WHH empowers 10 local CSOs to promote technical education and fosters collaboration through a TEVTA visit, benefiting communities in Bahawalpur region.





## Strengthening the capacity of local CSOs

Development of 10 union councils' development Plans (UCDPs) and 20 grant proposals derived from 20 workshops conducted in partnership of concern world wide and EU.



61 CSO members from Bahawalpur visited the Local Government Academy in Lala Mousa to learn about local governance and community-level service provision. This exposure visit enhances their ability to advocate for improved services and governance in their communities

## LPP's Contribution to Youth protection

LPP supported Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) in conducting the "Empowering Young Players for Their Own Protection" initiative, fostering child protection awareness among young athletes, coaches, and managers. This collaborative effort prioritized child safety in sports, emphasizing shared responsibility.
